- 1. IEP meeting to initiate interim placement
- 2. Parent completes and signs request for Specialized Health Care Services (SELPA form 7.6)
- 3. If necessary, the IEP team changes placement to home teaching (30 day home teaching time line begins)

Next steps:

- 1. Nurse completes interview
- 2. Nurse sends protocol for procedure and authorization to physician (SELPA forms 7.7 and 12.3.a).

Physician instructions/authorization received by nurse.

- 2. Copies of SELPA forms given to parent, nurse, general education teacher, special education teacher, case manager, and health care provider.

Next steps:

- 1. Training for staff begins
- 2. Training documented
